This Statement is made on behalf of Altered Images Limited with regards to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 which requires employers to be transparent about their efforts to eradicate Slavery and Human Trafficking in their supply chain.

This statement details our policies and practices in recognising and preventing human trafficking and slavery in our supply chain.

Altered Images Limited is a reseller of broadcast video equipment and have been delivering broadcast solutions and asset media management provisions to our clients, such as universities, production companies and government institutions for 20 years.

Our supply chain includes procurement of equipment from long established manufacturers in the video industry. We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or any part of our business.

We have always conducted our business ethically and with integrity and procedures are now in place to ensure slavery and human trafficking is nowhere in our supply chains.

As part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risk, we ensure that any suppliers we use have completed our questionnaires in relation to slavery and human trafficking. We ensure that we work with suppliers and manufacturers who treat their obligations towards modern slavery with the same importance that we do.

We have in place systems to :-

- · Identity and assess potential risk areas in our supply chains
- Mitigate the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in our supply chains
- Monitor potential risk areas in our supply chains

We are committed to ensuring that our staff and our suppliers have a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking and that any infringement of the Modern Slavery Act of 2015 will be reported.
